To help reduce processing and treatment times and safeguard our environment, remember to fill bins correctly and safely.

More bins requiring collection can mean:



Additional truck journeys and more miles travelled.



Greater time spent processing bins at the healthcare site's waste storage area.



Extra bins are emptied, disinfected and resupplied to hospitals from the waste.

WILL REDUCE THE NUMBER OF BINS BY 250. ↓

How to fill a bin correctly:

- Ensure the correct waste stream is placed in the appropriate bin
- Maximise any available space
- Place waste bags & containers as evenly as possible inside each wheeled unit
- Ensure that each bin can be closed and locked to prevent overflowing
