

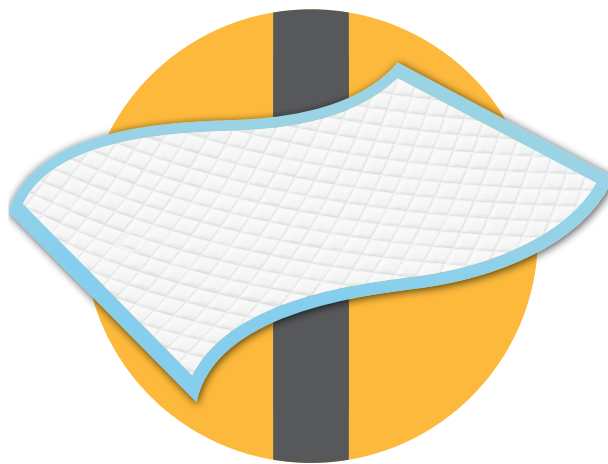
Tiger Bags

Used for:

Offensive waste from the treatment of **non-infectious patients contaminated with body fluids**



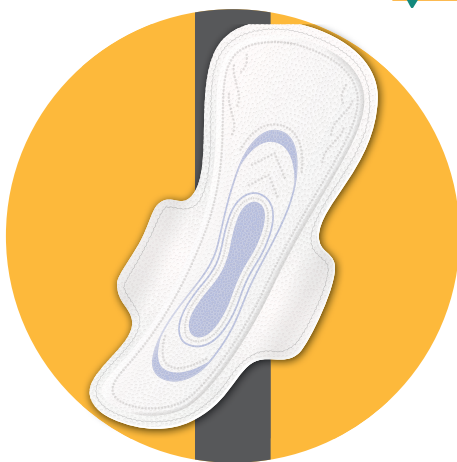
Nappies & Wipes



Incontinence Pads



PPE (contaminated with non-infectious body fluids)



Sanitary Products



Dressings & Bandages (contaminated with non-infectious body fluids)

Do not use for:



Pharmaceuticals
– blister packs,
medicine vials



General waste



Sharps



Glass



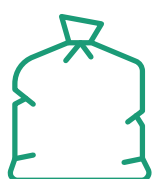
Free Liquids



Gas canisters



Rigid items likely
to puncture
the bag



Bags should be filled no more than two thirds full OR to a maximum weight of 8kg, whichever is reached first.

Bags should be sealed at the point of production using the swan-neck method.
